Health consultation - § 10 Prostitute Protection Act

Prostitute Protection Act

The Prostitution Protection Act has been in effect nationwide since July 1, 2017. According to §10 of the Prostitution Protection Act, all sex workers are required to receive a health consultation. The consultation provides information on disease prevention, contraception, and the risks associated with alcohol and drug use.

Who?

• This law applies to all individuals working in prostitution. It addresses people offering erotic and sexual services, such as erotic massages or escort services in exchange for payment.

How?

- The health consultation has to take place **prior** to the registration at the regulatory office.
- To schedule an appointment, please call the following number: 06151-3309-0.
- Please bring your identification documents (ID card or passport).
- Fee for the consultation and certificate: 44 € (payable in cash or by debit card).
- Please note that appearing in person is mandatory. If there are language barriers, you may bring someone to assist with translation. Information materials are available in different languages.
- The certificate contains the following information: first name and surname, date of birth, date and location of the consultation. An alias certificate (an additional certificate with a fictitious working name) can also be issued.
- The certificate is valid throughout Germany. A follow-up consultation must take place at least every 12 months for individuals aged 21 or older. For those under 21, a follow-up consultation must occur no later than every 6 months.
- The health consultation is confidential. No data will be shared.
- This is solely a consultation and does NOT include any examination.
